Purpose:	Bushkids is a weekly inquiry-based program, which takes place over an 8-week consecutive period, each Thursday during term 3. Bushkids allows students to investigate, explore and problem solve within their local environment and engage with many curriculum outcomes before, during and after the bush learning experience. Students will also have opportunities to build social skills and resilience while interacting with peers across the kindergarten unit.
